Gradebook Codes Used

- o **ABS** – Student is absent and work must be made up
- o **Y or N** – Means “Yes” or “No” for assignment or form turn in
- o **TI** – Means “Turned In” the assignment/form has been turned in
 - It could be a permission slip that just need to be turned in, with no grade
 - It could be a project/research paper that the teacher is in the process of grading
- o **X** – Student is exempt/excused from this assignment
- o **Z** – Assignment is missing/late, but can still be turned in
- o **Blank** – Grade not entered yet, possibly because:
 - the student was absent
 - the teacher has entered assignment in ahead of time (before the due date)
 - the assignment hasn’t been graded

Where can I see my child’s grades?

- o Click on the “Classes” icon at the top of the page to view “live” grades for individual assignments as well as “live” overall percentages for each course.
 - o Course alerts: once a week
 - o Classwork alerts: daily email
- o Click on the “Grades” icon at the top of the page to view a weekly “snapshot” of letter grades for your child’s courses.
