# Who has chromebooks?

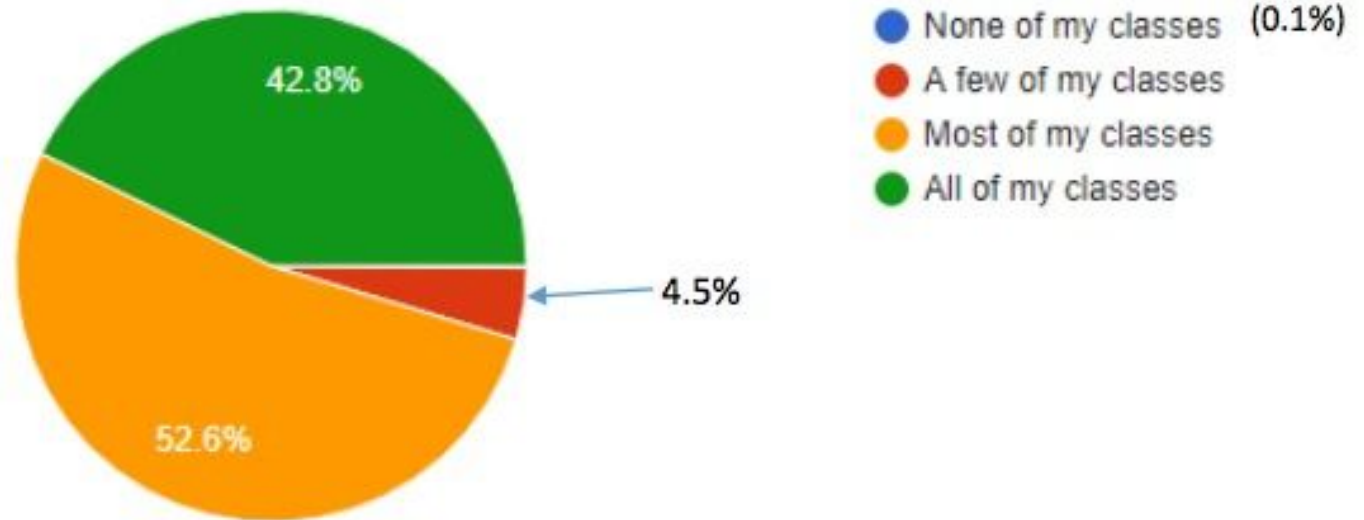
- All 6,000+ middle school student - 2nd year

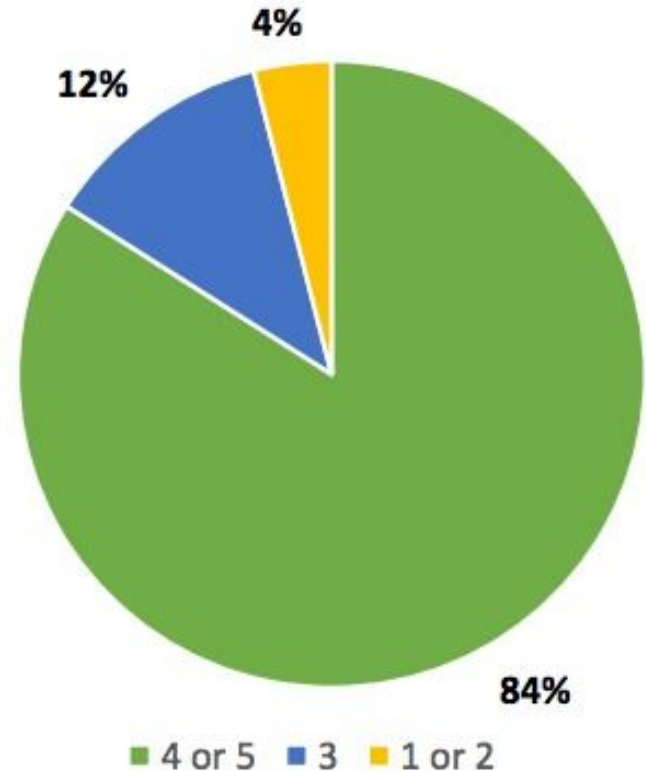
- Taking Tests/Quizzes – **99%**

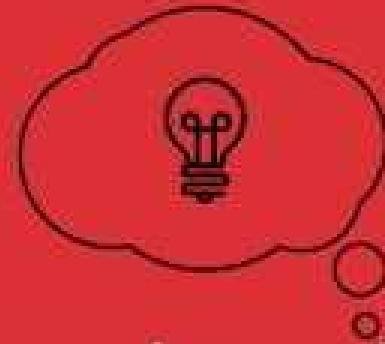

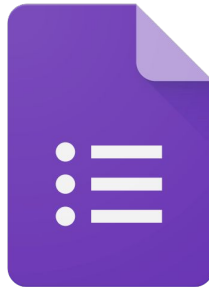
